

General Guidelines - Rhythm'26

ENTRY & ACCESS:

- Entry to Rhythm'26 will be strictly through a valid QR Code pass.
- QR codes will be scanned at the entry gate; screenshots, forwarded, duplicated, or tampered QR codes will not be accepted.
- Each QR code is valid for single use only and is non-transferable.

ENTRY TIMINGS:

- Last entry to the fest is strictly at 5:00 PM.
- Entry will not be permitted after 5:00 PM under any circumstances.

NO RE-ENTRY POLICY:

- No re-entry is allowed once you exit the venue.
- Attendees are advised to plan their entry accordingly.

IDENTITY VERIFICATION:

- All attendees must carry a valid college ID / government-issued ID along with the QR pass.
- Entry may be denied if identity verification fails.

DRESSING GUIDELINES (STRICTLY ENFORCED):

- Attire must be decent, respectful, and appropriate for a university environment.
- Girls' dressing guidelines will be strictly followed as per university norms.
- Outfits deemed inappropriate by the organizing or security team may lead to denial of entry.
- The decision of the organizing and security team in this matter will be final.

SECURITY & PROHIBITED ITEMS:

- Security checks are mandatory at all entry points.
- Alcohol, drugs, cigarettes, vapes, tobacco products, sharp objects, weapons, or inflammable items are strictly prohibited.
- Any violation will result in immediate removal from the venue.

BEHAVIOR & CODE OF CONDUCT:

- Attendees are expected to maintain discipline, decorum, and respectful behavior at all times.
- Misbehavior, harassment, or use of abusive language will lead to immediate expulsion from the fest.
- Damage to university property will attract strict disciplinary action.

SAFETY & RESPONSIBILITY:

- The organizing committee will not be responsible for loss, theft, or damage of personal belongings.
- Attendees are advised to take care of their valuables.
- Instructions issued by volunteers, coordinators, and security personnel must be followed at all times.

AUTHORITY OF THE ORGANIZING COMMITTEE:

- The Rhythm'26 Organizing Committee and JECRC University authorities reserve the right to deny entry, remove individuals violating guidelines, modify entry rules, or take disciplinary action.
